Dear parents/carers,

Thank you for the suggestions for improvement made in our survey last term. The results are attached and comments included. We have tried to address the areas where parents/carers or children have made suggestions and would like to tell you about them here.

"I think the playground could be a bit improved"

We do too! We have plans in place to repair and refurbish the outside garden and play area. This area was devastated by last year's floods and has never been the same since. We have submitted plans to our insurance company who have said they will repair it but are waiting for their response. We will let you know more information when they contact us.

"A school lunch menu that could be taken home would be good."

"Parents could be told what their child has for lunch"

We have produced a summary table of the three week menu for you to keep at home and it is attached to this form. We hope it is useful and will send out new ones every time the menu is changed.

"I would like to know what my child has been up to through the day and their daily routine and regular feedback on her progress"

Each class has a visual timetable up in their room that shows the children what they are doing that day and in what order. We have plans up on the notice boards in each classroom to let parents know what the children are doing each week and will be sending out a daily routine sheet for each class soon. Please ask individual class staff for specific information about

your own child and you can look through their Learning Journal at any time for more information about their progress. The Journals are in baskets in the classrooms and also have lots of photos for you to see your child busy in action at Nursery.

"The gate time needs improvement as it's not always open for 9 a.m."

We have two new members of staff this term and Mrs. Andrews will be opening the gate each morning at 9 a.m. so hopefully it will be on time from now on.

"What I dislike is the car park outside. There isn't enough space for cars and pedestrians. It needs speed bumps as you access the car park."

"Just one thing, the car park needs improved, especially parents parking. It should be staff only and stop the parents parking because there might be an accident."

We agree with you all that the car park needs improving. The car park is not ours unfortunately so we can't make any changes to it by ourselves. It is managed by the City Council. We have written to the City Council Highways Department and have been told that they will be coming out soon to look at the difficulties in the car park area and will try to help us resolve some of these problems. Any help you can give us with trying to get the Car Park made safer would be most welcomed.
